

A Russian Show at EE Fine Art

Trio of artists display highly collectable works

Between 23 January and 12 February EE Fine Art will be presenting a group exhibition displaying exceptional work by three Russian artists whose shows have already been spanning the globe and whose work is highly collectable as well as aesthetically pleasing.

Sheludyakov has been a member of the International Federation of Artists and the National Creative Union of Russian Artists since 2001. His expertise covers different styles and reflects his exposure to humanitarian studies, architecture and monumental painting while being a student. The artist's very own artistic technique is reminiscent of expressionism and medieval paintings.

Demovidova focuses her work on the female body in relation to objects like food or insects in order to explore this connection. She modulates her figures in thick brushstrokes, strong colours and accentuated shadows whose exaggerated features clearly attract the viewer's attention.

Evstafiev's expressionistic land- and cityscapes

are absolutely captivating. The vivid colours and hectic graphic brush strokes evoke a sensation of complexity, density and activity. Evstafiev's shows regularly sell out and his work has appeared in leading international magazines and newspapers and is published in numerous books.
