Continuing at EE Fine Art in Cobble Yard this month is their exhibition of exceptional work by new Russian artists – Anna Demovidova, Oleg Sheludyakov and Mikhail Evstafiev. Demovidova's paintings investigate the female body in relation to objects such as food or insects. Using thick brushstrokes, strong colours and accentuated shadows each piece grabs the viewer's attention. Sheludyakov works in different styles in painting, ceramics and sculpture, and his work has been represented in many art collections worldwide. In contrast Eystafiev's expressionistic land and cityscapes are captivating to the eye. February also sees a new solo exhibition of work by Hungarian artist Prokop Igor Jenó. His latest glassware and paintings show inspiration taken from colours and shapes within nature and are

clearly influenced by his varied studies in subjects such as biology, philosophy and film aesthetics.
