

# EE FINE ART'S CHRISTMAS SHOW



Cobble Yard, just off Napier Street at the back of The Grafton centre, is one of the most interesting little shopping areas in the city, home to small independent traders selling everything from

handcrafted designer jewellery to Polish smoked sausages. Since earlier this year it has also been home to one of the city's most interesting galleries – EE Fine Art which sells and displays modern and contemporary art from eastern Europe and Russia.

This month EE Fine Art's Christmas Show contains a fine array of paintings, original prints and glassware – perfect for gifts with a difference and ranging in price from £50 to £1500. The gallery will offer a wide selection of different styles from cubism to surrealism, impressionism to futurism, and naïve art to graffiti, by talented established and emerging artists including Jindrich Pevny, Zsolt Gyarmati, Prokop Igor Jenó, Andrey Lipatov, Lena Kurovska, Ilgvars Zalans, Adrian Doni, Roxana Donisanu, Adrian Paiu and Dmytro Dobrovolsky.

Fascinating and colourful glassware by Prokop Igor Jenó will be exhibited alongside Adrian Paiu's brilliant dark surrealism paintings, which have their very own mystical style; while beautiful impressionistic works by Dmytro Dobrovolsky, Lena Kurovska and Ilgvars Zalans will be shown next to the cutting-edge pieces of Zsolt Gyarmati, who combines his graffitis on canvas with large rivets and ropes. Andrey Lipatov's folk art and Adrian Doni's cubistic people and still lives, with which he has had great success in his own country and the USA, can be seen next to Jindrich Pevny's amazing prints from wood and stone carvings. All pieces will be in manageable sizes and will be framed and ready to be taken off the wall. As an incentive the gallery will also be offering a 10% discount on anything bought during the private view.
