



## FEDOR ALEXEEV CURRICULUM VITAE

Fedor Alexeev was born into a family of actors in Leningrad in 1952. While studying at the Technological Institute in Moscow he discovered his passion for art and devoted the next 12 years to studying painting. Since 1989 he has been participating in numerous group exhibitions in Russia, Germany and America. He has also been presented in various solo shows in Russia and Japan and his work is widely collected in Russia, Finland and America. Fedor Alexeev is a member of the Painters' Association of Russia and he exclusively paints St. Petersburg scenery. His artistic process always starts with drawing the chosen scene and transforming the three dimensional cityscape into the simplest geometrical planes in order to construct scene. Colour and colour planes play an essential role in the work of Fedor Alexeev's, his objective is to find a correlation of colours in his compositions and to give each separate colour its own part in the ensemble. "I don't choose colours. I just test their behaviour to each other. I do my best to let colours have self-expression" says the artist. Having started creating his own pictorial system he wants to let go of all rules of conceiving, conducting and completing a picture.
